As per Office Report, the respondent has been duly served. The petitioner is the wife and the respondent is the husband. The petitioner is a resident of Rudrapur in district Udham Singh Nagar, Uttarakhand. The respondent- husband is a resident of Gurugram. There are three proceedings pending between the parties. The first is a petition for divorce filed by respondent- husband pending before the Family Court, North- West Delhi. The petitioner has filed a petition under Section 125 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. The respondent has filed a petition under Section 25 of the Guardians and Wards Act, 1890. These two proceedings are pending before the Family Court at Udham Singh Nagar in the State of Uttarakhand.
