Delay condoned.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
respondent No. 1 has been convicted for offence under

Sections 376 and 342 of the Indian Penal Code (IPC) and sentenced to undergo Rigorous Imprisonment for 10 years. However, he has been granted bail by the High Court, where the appeal is pending, when he had undergone only one year of the sentence awarded to him. It is also stated that even the compensation granted by the trial Court has not been paid. Another submission is that after the respondent has been released on bail, he is threatening the family members of the petitioner and even an FIR is registered to this effect.

We are of the opinion that the petitioner, on the aforesaid grounds, can approach the High Court seeking cancellation of the bail granted to respondent No. 1.

With these observations, the special leave petition stands disposed of.
