We have heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has drawn our attention to page 47 to contend that the investigation by the DCP would not subserve justice as the SHO allegedly was acting against the petitioner at the behest of the DCP.

We are of the view that the appropriate course to adopt in the present case would be to direct the Commissioner of Police, Delhi to appoint an officer of sufficient seniority to look into the complaint of the petitioner, whether it be against the SHO or the DCP, and whether it was related to alleged police brutality or for providing protection.

The necessary action be initiated by the Commissioner within one week of receipt of the order.

The special leave petition accordingly stands disposed of.
