O R D E R

The Court is convened through Video Conferencing.

Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner as also the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent - State.

Taking into consideration the fact that the petitioner has suffered incarceration for more than 3 ½ year and the similarly situated 24 other accused persons have been granted bail by the High Court and the co-accused/main accused have also been granted

bail by this Court vide orders dated 17.04.2020, 06.10.2020 and 02.11.2020, we are inclined to grant bail to the petitioner herein.

The petitioner is, accordingly, directed to be enlarged on bail on terms and conditions to be imposed by the trial court.

The special leave petition stands disposed of accordingly.

As a sequel to the above, pending interlocutory applications also stand disposed of.

However, the petitioner is directed not to interfere in the trial process or try to influence the witnesses.

If the petitioner does not comply with the aforesaid directions, the respondent - State would be at liberty to approach this Court for cancellation of bail granted to the petitioner herein.
