O R D E R

This Court *vide* order dated 19.06.2020 had directed time bound disposal of the matter pending before the Trial Court. That did not happen because of situation prevailing at the relevant time.

This Court extended time on two occasions. Now, communication No.1083/Court/2021 dated 02.09.2021 has been received from Mr. Mukesh Nath, Judge, 22<sup>nd</sup> Additional Sessions Judge, Indore,

Madhya Pradesh, mentioning that the prosecution has closed its evidence and the case has been fixed for accused's statements under Section 313 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

We need not dwell upon the reasons for the time taken by the Trial Court to dispose of the proceedings except to observe that by way of indulgence we grant three months' further time from today to the concerned Judge with further direction to concerned administrative authority to ensure that during that period, the incumbent Trial Court Judge (Mr. Mukesh Nath, Judge) disposes of the proceedings finally and report compliance and until disposal of the trial, he shall not be transferred or assigned any other work, which would delay the proceedings any further.

Miscellaneous application is accordingly disposed of.
