

Judge in Writ Petition (C) No.6568/2017 shall not be given effect to during the pendency of the Writ Appeal No.12/2020 before the Division Bench of the High Court.

Needless to observe that the contempt petition pending before the High Court in reference to the order passed by the learned Single Judge shall not be proceeded with in terms of this order.

2. The learned Single Judge is requested to decide the review petition filed by the private respondent expeditiously, preferably within one month from the receipt of copy of this order.

3. The Division Bench may thereafter expeditiously proceed with the Writ Appeal No.12/2020 including any other cross appeal or further appeal to be filed by the parties after the review order is passed, preferably within two months from the date of review order.

Both parties through their respective

counsel have assured that they will extend full cooperation in proceedings pending before the High Court for early disposal and will not pray for adjournment on any count, whenever the matter is listed for hearing.

The special leave petition and pending application(s), if any shall stand disposed of accordingly.
