O R D E R

The present SLP arises out of dismissal of the application for bail preferred by the petitioner. The petitioner alongwith co-accused is alleged for committed offences punishable under the NDPS Act. The petitioner has been in custody since March, 2020.

We have been apprised that the charge-sheet has been filed in the matter but the charges are yet to be framed.

We see no reason to interfere.
