**ORDER**

1 Leave granted.

2 The National Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission<sup>1</sup>, by its judgment and order dated 9 April 2019, declined to condone the delay on the part of the appellant in filing a revision against the order of the State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission<sup>2</sup> dated 13 July 2016.

3 Notice was issued by this Court on 5 August 2019, in pursuance of which the respondent has entered appearance and filed a counter affidavit.

4 After considering the nature and circumstances of the present case and the issues involved, we are of the view that the ends of justice require that the delay on the part of the appellant, which is stated to be 171 days, should be condoned and the revision before the NCDRC be directed to be

heard on merits, subject to the payment of costs which would be a condition precedent.

5 We order accordingly and impose costs of Rs 50,000 upon the appellant which shall be paid over to the respondent within a period of six weeks from today. If the appellant fails to pay the costs within six weeks from today, the appellant shall lose the benefit of this order and the order passed by the NCDRC shall stand. In the event that the costs are paid over to the respondent within the aforesaid period, the revision shall stand restored to the file of the NCDRC for disposal on merits.

6 The appeal is accordingly disposed of.
