UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following

O R D E R

The Court is convened through Video Conferencing.

Having heard learned Senior counsel appearing for the petitioner, learned counsel appearing for the State of U.P. and perusing the material available on record, we are not inclined to grant regular bail to the petitioner because of the serious allegations levelled against him in the matter.

However, learned Senior counsel submits that the petitioner's father has expired and as he was in jail, he could not perform the

last rites of his late father. In addition to that, learned Senior counsel submits that the petitioner's mother's health condition is serious.

Taking into consideration the submissions made by the learned Senior counsel for the petitioner, we are inclined to grant interim bail to the petitioner for a period of six weeks from today.

The petitioner is, accordingly, directed to be enlarged on interim bail, on furnishing a personal bond along with an undertaking that he shall surrender after the expiry of the said six week's period, i.e., 25th March, 2021 before the concerned Jail Authorities without fail.

With the aforesaid observations, the Special Leave Petition is disposed of.
