UPON hearing the counsel through Video Conference, the Court made the following

O R D E R

SLP(C) Nos. 4410-4433/2020

Ms. M E Mazumdar, Ld. Counsel has filed memo of appearance on behalf of Respondent No.5. Four weeks time is given to file vakalatnama and the counter affidavit.

Mr. Amalpushp Shroti, Ld. Counsel has filed counter affidavit on behalf of Respondent Nos. 18 and 20 to 25 but the same is defective. Four weeks time is given to cure the same.

Respondent Nos. 1 to 4, 7, 8 and 15 have already filed counter affidavit.

Service of notice is complete on respondent No.11 but none has entered appearance on his behalf.

Four weeks time is given to respondent Nos. 6, 14 and 26 to file the counter affidavit.

Two weeks time is given to learned counsel for the petitioner for filing the affidavit in proof of dasti service of notice already issued to the respondent Nos. 9, 10, 12, 13, 16, 17 and 19.

SLP(C) Nos. 5632-5653/2020

Mr. Rohit K. Singh, Ld. Counsel has filed vakalatnama and memo of appearance on behalf of Respondent Nos. 1 to 4 without taking NOC from the erstwhile Ld. Counsel. Mr. Amalpushp Shroti.

Four weeks time is given to obtain "NOC" and for filing counter affidavit.

SLP(C) Nos. 6915-6950/2020

Mr. Siddharth Jain, Ld. Counsel has filed vakalatnama on behalf of Resident Commissioner (Employee Provident Fund) alongwith letter for exemption of welfare stamp. Four weeks time is given for filing the counter affidavit as well as for filing welfare stamp.

Learned counsel for the petitioner shall within a period of two weeks file the fresh particulars of the unserved respondents and he shall also take fresh steps for the service of notice to them within the same period.

SLP(C) Nos. 16808/2021

Four weeks time is given to respondent Nos. 1 to 6 and 11 to file the counter affidavit.

Service of notice is complete on respondent Nos. 7 to 10 but no one has entered appearance on their behalf.

SLP(C) Nos.16809-16810/2021

Four weeks time is given to respondent Nos. 1 to 8 and 27 to file the counter affidavit.

Service of notice is complete on respondent Nos. 9 to 24 but no one has entered appearance on their behalf.

Learned counsel for the petitioner shall within a period of

two weeks file the fresh particulars of Respondent Nos. 25 and 26 and he shall also take fresh steps for the service of notice to them within the same period.

SLP(C) Nos. 14200-14230, 14272-14281 and 14282-14287/2021

Mr. Amit Kumar, Ld. Counsel submits that he has already filed the vakalatnama on behalf of Respondent Nos. 5, 12 and 39 on 25.9.2021. but the same has not been reflected in the Office Report. Registry to verify the same and report accordingly. If the same is filed four weeks time is given for filing counter affidavit.

In above-mentioned matters Ld. Counsel for petitioner has filed spare copies for issuance of notice but notice could not be issued as application for condonation of delay has not been filed. However, on oral request the delay is condoned.

Ld. Counsel for petitioner has filed deficit court fee and printing charges. Two weeks time is given to do the needful.

However, Ld. Counsel has filed vakalatnama on behalf of some of Respondents. Four weeks time is given to file counter affidavit.

Sole petitioner in SLP(C) Nos. 14214-14215 of 2021 has expired. Ld.Counsel for petitioner has filed an application for substitution. The same be processed as per rules.

Four weeks time is given to respondent Nos. 1 to 5, 8 to 15 and 33 to file the counter affidavit.

Service of notice is complete on respondent Nos. 6, 7 and 16 to 30 but no one has entered appearance on their behalf.

Learned counsel for the petitioner shall within a period of two weeks file the fresh particulars of Respondent Nos. 31 and 32 and he shall also take fresh steps for the service of notice to them within the same period.

Four weeks time is given to respondent Nos. 1 to 8 and 16 to file the counter affidavit.
