O R D E R

The Court is convened through Video Conferencing.

Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner as also the learned Deputy Advocate General appearing on behalf of the respondent - State and carefully perused the material placed on record including the counter affidavit filed by the respondent - State.

Although learned Deputy Advocate General appearing on behalf of the respondent - State vehemently opposed the prayer for granting bail to the petitioner herein yet taking into consideration the *prima facie* material placed before us as also the facts that the petitioner is in custody since 27.04.2019, 9

witnesses have been examined and his name has been included in the supplementary charge sheet, we are of the considered view that it is a fit case to grant bail to the petitioner herein.

The petitioner is, accordingly, directed to be enlarged on bail subject to the conditions that he and his wife shall surrender their passports, if not already surrendered, before the trial court and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

It is stated by the learned counsel for the petitioner that his client has already closed the cyber café. If that be so, the petitioner is directed not to open the same.

The trial court may impose any other condition as it deems fit and necessary.

The special leave petition stands disposed of accordingly.

In case the petitioner is found to have violated any of his bail conditions or attempted to have tampered the evidence, influence witnesses, or hamper the trial in any other way, then the respondent - State shall be at liberty to approach this Court for cancellation of bail granted to the petitioner.
