UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

The petitioner has been charged for the offence punishable  
under Section 307 IPC.

The bail application filed by the petitioner was dismissed by  
the Trial Court as well as by the High Court. Being aggrieved by  
the dismissal of the bail application, the petitioner has preferred

this special leave petition.

We have heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner as well as learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-State of Maharashtra.

By perusal of the custody certificate, it is seen that the petitioner is in custody from 26.10.2017. Learned counsel appearing for the State of Maharashtra has submitted that the chargesheet has been filed and the trial has already been commenced.

Considering the period of custody and the fact that the chargesheet has been filed and other facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his executing bail bonds for a sum of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties (local sureties with authenticity and other relevant documents) in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court.

The petitioner shall not influence any witnesses and shall cooperate with further progress of the trial.

The petitioner-accused is directed to report before the concerned committal Court once in first and third Monday of the week.

The special leave petition is, accordingly, disposed of.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
