1. In this petition, prayer has been made for review of order dated 07.12.2017 passed in Criminal Appeal No.1413/2008.

2. The petitioner has also filed an application for condonation of 1350 days' delay in filing the review petition. We have perused the averments contained in the application for condonation of delay and are convinced that the explanation given by the petitioner is wholly unsatisfactory. Therefore, the application for condonation of delay is dismissed. As a sequel to this, the review petition is liable to be dismissed as barred by time.
