Heard learned counsels for the parties.

Having regard to the grounds on which transfer has been prayed for, we are satisfied with the grievance expressed by the petitioner-wife and we accept the same. Therefore, the case being G.W.O.P. No. 4535/2018 titled as "*C. Arun Chella Samraj Mukilesh vs. Anitha Subramanian*" pending before the III Additional Family Court, Chennai, Tamil Nadu is ordered to be transferred to the Court of Judge, Family Court, Mumbai, Maharashtra.

The case record shall be sent to the transferee Court promptly and without any delay.
