O R D E R

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

This special leave petition has been filed against order dated 20.08.2020 passed by the High Court in MCRC No. 25176/2020, by which ninth bail application filed by the petitioner under Section 439, CRPC have been rejected for offences under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of the IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the trial is in progress and the petitioner is in custody for about 3 years and

5 months. He further submits that co-accused - Radheshyam Kulshresth and Suresh Masani have been granted bail by this Court as well as by the High Court.

Learned counsel for the State submits that 13 witnesses have already been examined out of 27 and one more has been examined and this Court may direct that the trial may be expeditiously held.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and perusing the record, we are of the view that the petitioner may also be released on bail on such terms and conditions as fixed by the Trial Court. One of the condition to be imposed by the Trial Court shall be that the petitioner shall appear in the trial on every date unless exempted by the Court.

The special leave petition stands disposed of accordingly.
