O R D E R

1. The petitioner-wife has filed the instant petition under Section 25 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 before this Court seeking transfer of case bearing Matrimonial Case No.1274/2024, titled as "Ravi Kumar vs. Seema Kumari", pending before the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Mathura to the Principal Judge, Family Court at Dwarka Courts, New Delhi.

2. Vide order dated 03.09.2025, by the consent of the parties, the matter was referred to the Supreme Court Mediation Centre to explore the possibility of arriving at an amicable settlement. The Mediation Report dated 08.10.2025 indicates that the parties are not agreeable to arrive at an amicable settlement at this stage.

3. Having heard learned counsel appearing for the parties and taking into consideration the grounds taken in the Transfer Petition, we allow the Transfer Petition and direct the transfer of case bearing Matrimonial Case No.1274/2024, titled as "Ravi Kumar vs. Seema Kumari", pending before the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Mathura to the Principal Judge, Family Court at

Dwarka Courts, New Delhi.

4. Let the record of the case be transferred without delay.
5. A copy of this order be sent to the concerned court for compliance.
6. If video conferencing facility is available with the transferee court, the benefit of the same shall be extended to the parties.
7. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
