O R D E R

We are informed that pursuant to the impugned order remanding the adjudication to the Industrial Tribunal, an Award was passed holding that the petitioner belongs to the category of Workman. There was also a direction from the Tribunal to reinstate the petitioner with the backwages. That order was challenged before the High Court. The learned Single Judge by judgment dated 12.04.2017 allowed the Writ Petition. The petitioner before us challenged the same in an intra Court appeal. The said Letters Patent Appeal was dismissed on 14.07.2017. The petitioner filed a

review and that also was dismissed on 13.09.2017. The petitioner submits that the order dismissing the LPA and the Review Petition are being challenged before this Court.

Therefore, without prejudice to the liberty available to the petitioner to take all available contentions in that challenge, the special leave petitions are dismissed as having become infructuous.
