O R D E R

It is not in dispute that the Letters Patent Appeals are pending before the High Court. It is also not in dispute that the present Special Leave Petitions have been filed against the interim directions issued by the High Court pending the Letters Patent Appeals. It appears that at the relevant time, the directions were issued during the COVID-19 period. One of the directions issued by the High Court was to upload the financial statements of seven months which has been stayed by

this Court. We direct to continue the interim relief granted on 07.01.2021 and 12.03.2021 in the present proceedings till the final disposal of the Letters Patent Appeals before the High Court. It will be open for the petitioners to request the High Court, not to continue the said directions as the same were issued during the COVID-19 period and the High Court to consider the same in accordance with law and on its own merits.
