O R D E R

Vide order dated 17.10.2019 we held the respondent guilty of offence under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instrument Act. The respondent was directed to pay Rs.10,77,712/- as fine and Rs. 1,00,000/- as cost of litigation to the petitioner within a period of three months. In default, respondent was directed to undergo imprisonment for a period of six months.

This application has been filed for extension of time for payment of the amount as directed by this Court vide order dated 17.10.2019.

Mr. B.S. Banthia, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the amount may directly be paid to the petitioner within the time that is sought by the respondent in this application.

Respondent is directed to pay Rs.5 lakhs to the petitioner directly within a period of one week from today and the remaining amount within a period of four months from today. No further

application for extension shall be entertained.

The miscellaneous application stands disposed of.
