Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has been arrested and is in custody since August, 2017 and the charges are likely to be framed today coupled with the fact that assurance is given by the learned counsel for the State that the trial will be concluded within eight months from today and including that the

misappropriation attributed to the petitioner is only a sum of Rs. 7,20,592/-, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing a personal bond of Rs. 10 lakhs and on such other terms and conditions as may be imposed by the Trial Court.

The petitioner shall extend full cooperation for early disposal of the trial. If he is responsible for delay of the trial in any manner, it will be open to the Trial Court to consider prayer for cancellation of bail on that count.

The Special Leave Petition is disposed of accordingly.
