UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. The delay of 55 days in filing the present petitions is condoned in the facts and circumstances of the case. Accordingly, I.A. No. 122557/2025 is allowed.
2. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, we are not satisfied that any case for interference under Article 136 of the Constitution of India is made out.

3. The present petitions are, accordingly, dismissed.

4. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks sometime to vacate the subject-premises. Accordingly, we allow the petitioner three months' time from the end of June, 2025 to vacate the subject-premises provided the petitioner submits an undertaking on affidavit within two weeks before the Trial Court that he will vacate the subject-premises within the aforesaid timeframe and hand over vacant and peaceful possession to the landlord.

5. It goes without saying that the petitioner will clear all outstanding dues and continue to pay the rent/damages for the period till he occupies the premises.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
