O R D E R

We have heard learned Senior Counsel appearing for the parties and perused the documents filed along with the Petition and rejoinder affidavit, additional documents as also the allegations made in the Contempt Petition.

We are satisfied that the present case requires to be allowed by ordering the transfer of Original Petition No.212/2017 titled as 'M. Arun Kumar v. Rathi Arunkumar' pending before the High Court of Judicature at Madras to the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Bengaluru, Karnataka. The transferor Court shall forthwith transmit the entire record relating to the aforesaid case to the transferee Court for deciding the case in accordance with law.

The Family Court Judge shall explore the possibilities of mediation between the parties expeditiously and preferably within a period of two months from the date of filing of certified copy of this order and in case the mediation fails, decide the plea of giving

visitation rights to the respondent. All pleas regarding the visitation rights will be open to be raised before the Learned Family Judge.

The Transfer Petition is allowed in the aforesaid terms.

Consequently, C.P.(C) NO.1785/2017 is also disposed of.
