O R D E R

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and having perused the material placed on record, we do not find any reason to consider interference in the orders dated 18.08.2021 and 26.08.2021 passed by the High Court of Karnataka at Bengaluru in M.F.A. No. 2104 of 2019, making interim arrangements for stay and studies of the children.

Therefore, this petition is required to be dismissed.

However, it goes without saying that the main appeal pending before the High Court deserves expeditious consideration and this aspect has been indicated by this Court in the order dated

24.01.2020 in SLP(C) No. 26845 of 2018 as also in the order dated 25.05.2021 in SLP(C) No. 7139 of 2021. We would permit the petitioner to make a prayer before the High Court for expeditious final consideration of the matter.

We hope and trust that the High Court shall give due consideration to such a request, particularly having regard to the subject matter of this litigation as also the aforesaid orders passed by this Court earlier.

Subject to the observations foregoing, this special leave petition stands dismissed.

All the pending applications stand disposed of.
