UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

The impugned order granting bail to the private respondent herein was passed on 24.01.2017. Undisputedly, the said order is in operation. It is not on record that the private respondent has tried to influence the witnesses

or intimate the complainant. Also, it is not on record that the said respondent has tried to intimidate the complainant. Under the circumstances, we are not inclined to interfere with the impugned order. However, in the attending facts and circumstances, and considering the fact that the offence pertains to the year 2012, we direct the trial to be expedited. As such we request the trial Court to take measures, insofar as it is possible to complete the trial within a period of six months from today.

The parties are directed to appear before the trial Court on 30.04.2024.

The parties undertakes to fully cooperate. We expect the State/learned prosecutor to make available all witnesses to facilitate expeditious disposal of the trial.

The special leave petition is disposed of.
