O R D E R

Request for upgradation of the petitioners' school from VIII to XII standard was lastly denied on the ground that in respect of the land on which the school runs, there is no lease deed registered in respect thereof in favour of the petitioners. The petitioners had challenged the said decision of the respondents by filing writ petition in the High Court and the learned Single Judge, finding the aforesaid deficiency as correct, dismissed the petition. No doubt, thereafter the petitioners have got the lease deed

registered in respect of the land measuring 5000 square yards. This was mentioned before the Division Bench of the High Court. However, the Division Bench of the High Court held that it is a subsequent event which occurred after the judgment of the learned Single Judge and, therefore, the judgment of the learned Single Judge, on the facts before it, was correct. In view thereof, the High Court has granted permission to the petitioners to apply to the respondents again for upgradation.

In view of these facts, it is not necessary to entertain this petition. Suffice is to state that when the petitioners make an application and the same is considered, it would be considered objectively by the respondents and within a period of three months from the date of application. In case decision is not taken within the aforesaid period, the petitioners will be at liberty to file appropriate application in this petition itself.

The special leave petition stands disposed of.
