UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

At the outset, learned counsel for the parties submitted that the matter be referred to mediation before the Supreme Court Mediation Centre (SCMC). Accordingly, the matter is referred to the SCMC. The parties are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 15.04.2025 at 02:30 p.m.

2. Thereafter, liberty is granted to the parties to request the learned Mediator for their virtual appearance which shall be

decided by the learned Mediator. However, whenever the petitioner-wife is required to be physically present before the learned Mediator, she will be entitled to reimbursement which is quantified at Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) per visit. As initially, we have asked the parties to appear physically, let the respondent-husband transfer a sum of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) in the bank account of the petitioner-wife within a period of one week from today and details of such bank account shall be provided by the learned counsel for the petitioner to the learned counsel for the respondent during the course of the day.

3. Learned Mediator is requested to submit a report within a period of two months thereafter.

4. List the matter on 24.07.2025.
