Heard Ms.Suruchi Suri, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr.Anirudh Sanganeria, learned counsel for the respondent.

In the course of hearing, we have been apprised that the possession has been handed over to the petitioner and the arrears have also been paid by the other respondents to the petitioner-landlord except respondent No.1 -Natarajan.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is given to the first respondent to pay the amount within two months hence.

Keeping in view the aforesaid submission, we direct respondent No.1 - Natarajan to pay the arrears of rent to the petitioner-landlord within the time stipulated hereinabove.

The contempt petition stands disposed of accordingly.
