O R D E R

Heard Mr. Mukul Rohtagi, learned senior counsel for the petitioner.

A perusal of the High Court order and the material placed on record indicates that the application for bail of the petitioner is pending since 18.01.2017 and the petitioner is in jail for the

last 10 months. The matter was listed before the High Court on many times but adjourned for various reasons and the matter is again listed today i.e. on 21.08.2017. Learned senior counsel has brought to our notice a judgment of this Court in Hussain and Ors. Vs. Union of India 2017(5) SCC 702, to submit that the bail applications need speedy disposal.

Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of this case, and the aforesaid judgment, in case the matter has not been disposed of already, we request the High Court to consider and dispose of the application for bail of the petitioner within four weeks from the date of receipt of this order.

With the above observations, the special leave petition is disposed of.
