This is a transfer petition at the instance of the petitioner-wife seeking transfer of Regular Suit No.48 of 2016, titled as Naveen Chadha vs. Lakshita Malhotra, pending in the Court of Additional Principal Judge, Family Courts, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh to the Family Courts at District Gurgaon, Haryana.
