ORDER

Interlocutory Application Nos. 148116/2022, 6806/2021 and 148154/2022 seeking permission to appear and argue in-person stand(s) allowed.

The present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking transfer of the case initiated by F.I.R. No.0296 of 2019 registered with Police Station-Wakad Pune, Maharashtra, giving rise to RCC-4839 of 2019 titled "*State Vs. Sameer Goel*" (subject-case) pending in the Court of Judicial Magistrate at Pune, Maharashtra to the Court of Judicial Magistrate, Narwana, Haryana.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, the State and the respondent Nos. 2, 3 and 4 through virtual mode who have been appearing in-person.

On considering the facts and circumstances on the basis of which the petitioner seeks transfer of the subject-case, we are satisfied that it would be

We are passing this order as in course of hearing it has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the family home of the respondent is located at Panchkula.

The records of the proceedings shall be sent to the transferee Court and the Court of competent jurisdiction at Panchkula, Haryana shall proceed in the matter from the stage at which the matter is transferred to it.

The Transfer Petition stands allowed accordingly.
