O R D E R

SLP(Crl.) No. 6570/2017

Having regard to the circumstances of the
case, we consider it appropriate to reduce the amount

receivable by the respondents to Rs. 10,000/- each. This amount will be subject to revision, in an appropriate proceedings as the Court may consider appropriate on the basis of the evidence adduced before it.

The amount of arrears shall be quantified at Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs) payable to the wife within a period of 15 days.

Learned counsel for the respondent-wife has received an FDR(No. 11377319, ICICI Bank, Sector 34, Chandigarh) for Rs.7,00,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakhs) in the name of Daughter, namely Simran Kaur. The respondent is discharged from the Statement made on her behalf on 28.11.2017.
