ORDER

These transfer petitions have been filed by the petitioner-wife under Section 25 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 seeking transfer of H.M.A. Petition No. 530 of 2020, titled as "*Deepak Kumar Singh vs. Sapna Singh*", pending in the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh to the Judge, Family Court, Jalagaon, Maharashtra.

Service of show-cause notice is complete; the respondent-husband has entered appearance and has also filed counter affidavit but, no one appears for the respondent, though the matter is called out twice over.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the material placed on record.

Having considered the circumstances in their totality, we are of the view that in the interest of justice, transfer of the proceedings, as prayed for, is warranted.

The parties shall be at liberty to apply before the transferee court for appearing through the video conferencing mode.

The records of the case be transferred to the transferee court forthwith.
