This Court vide order dated 25.09.2019 had disposed of Special Leave Petition (c) No. 25101 of 2017. The said order reads as under:

"The State Bank of India has filed an application seeking permission to vacate the premises in question in this special leave petition. The State Bank of India was compelled to make such an application because of the interim order of *status quo* granted by this Court on 01.09.2017.

Since, the State Bank of India, the tenant, wants to voluntarily vacate the premises of the petitioner, Dr. Santosh Dixit, it is open for the Bank to vacate the premises in question.

In view of this, the premises in question will be falling vacant shortly. It is open for the petitioner to make an application before the concerned authorities after the Bank vacates the premises, seeking permission to make use of the ground floor of the premises for appropriate purposes, as permitted under the Rules and Regulations. On such application being made by the petitioner, the authority shall consider the same as per the Rules and Regulations, on merits and in accordance with law. We make it clear that the property should not be used for any other purpose except with the permission of the concerned authorities.

The special leave petition is accordingly disposed of."
