Having heard Mr. Aniruddha Deshmukh, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and Ms. Jaikriti S. Jadeja,

learned counsel appearing for the respondents, we have perused the petition papers.

Considering that the learned Single Judge has granted the benefit to the respondents, which has been upheld by the Division Bench of that Court, we see no reason to interfere with the concurrent Orders impugned in these petitions.

The learned counsel for the respondents however, contends that the Haryana Ordinance No.6/2013, which was in force at that time, has not been taken into consideration by the High Court.

However, keeping in view the circumstances arising in the instant case, we are of the opinion that the same will not alter the position but the interest of the petitioners would stand protected if it clarifies that the application of the Haryana (Abolition of Distinction of Pay Scale Between Technical and Non-Technical Posts Act) which has come into force, shall be taken into consideration in future cases, based on the facts therein and if the same arises for consideration before the High Court.

In that light, the Order(s) impugned herein, shall not be treated as precedent and all contentions in that regard are left open.

Petitions are accordingly, disposed of.

Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
