UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, we find no ground to interfere with the impugned judgment dated 18.03.2025, more so, when there is a concurrent finding of fact against the petitioner. However, six months' time is granted to the petitioner to vacate the premises, subject to the condition that she will file an undertaking before the Executing Court that she shall handover peaceful vacant possession to the respondent-decree holder immediately after the expiry of the period of six months.

2. Subject to such undertaking, the warrants of possession issued by the Executing Court shall be kept in abeyance.
3. The special leave petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
4. All pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
