UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

It is accepted that one of the respondents, namely, Gambheer,
(original accused no.1) has completed actual sentence of more than
5 years, while the other convicted accused have completed 18 months
of actual imprisonment.

It is also accepted that in a cross-case registered against the complainant's side, conviction has been recorded in respect of the offence punishable under Section 307 IPC.

Considering the circumstances on record, in our view, no case for interference is made out. We, therefore, dismiss the instant Special Leave Petition.

However, considering the circumstances on record, we give liberty to the petitioner to make an appropriate prayer to have pending appeal expedited.

Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
