O R D E R

1. This petition is filed under Section 25 of the Code of Civil Procedure seeking transfer of a case bearing Divorce Petition FCOP No. 215 of 2021 titled "*Gauttam Choudhary Vs. Jyoti Kulhari @ Jyoti*", pending before the Family Court, Secundrabad, Telangana to the Family Court, Jhunjhunu, Rajasthan.
2. The grounds raised by the petitioner for seeking the transfer are that she does not have any independent source of income; other cases are pending at Jhunjhunu; and also on account of long distance she is unable to effectively defend the proceedings at Secunderabad.
3. On such consideration, we are of the view that the transfer can be allowed. Consequently, the Transfer Petition is allowed.
4. Accordingly, case bearing Divorce Petition FCOP No. 215 of 2021 titled "*Gauttam Choudhary Vs. Jyoti Kulhari @ Jyoti*", pending before the Family Court, Secundrabad, Telangana is transferred to to the Family Court, Jhunjhunu, Rajasthan.

5. The transferor Court shall forward the records pertaining to the said case to the transferee Court, as expeditiously as possible.

6. Parties are directed to appear before the concerned Court on 10th March, 2026.

7. The Respondent-husband is permitted to attend the proceedings virtually, unless his physical presence is required by the trial Court.

8. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
