Heard Mr. Vijay Hansaria, learned senior counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Pawan Shree Agrawal, learned counsel for the State.

It is submitted by Mr. Hansaria, learned senior counsel that SLP (C) No.15856 of 2014 was not similar to the special leave petitions filed by the State and, therefore, it deserved to be differently dealt with or alternatively, the petitioner in the special leave petition be granted liberty to challenge the Cabinet decision before the High Court.

Mr. Pawan Shree Agrawal, learned counsel appearing for the State, though initially opposed the prayer, ultimately left it to the discretion of this Court.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties, we modify the order dated 10.01.2017 by stating that the petitioner in SLP (C)

No.15856 of 2014 will have the liberty to challenge the Cabinet decision even if he has not challenged before the High Court.

With the aforesaid modification in the order dated 10.01.2017, the review petition stands disposed of. No order as to costs.
