O R D E R

The transfer petitions, two in number, are filed one by the wife and the other by the husband.

We have heard learned counsel appearing for the wife and the learned counsel appearing for the husband.

On the one hand, the petitioner(wife) who has also filed petition in Khallikote, Orissa, wants the case filed by the respondent (husband) to be transferred from Delhi to Orissa.

Husband, on the other hand, would want the petition filed by the wife in Orissa to be transferred to Delhi.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, we are of the view that interest of justice would require that the transfer petition filed by the wife must be allowed and the transfer petition filed by the husband must be dismissed.

Accordingly, Transfer Petition (Civil) No. 542 of 2020 is allowed in terms of the prayer.

Transfer Petition (Civil) No. 1291 of 2020 will stand dismissed.
