Notice which is accepted by learned counsel for the respondent.

Heard learned counsel for parties. The respondent/applicant, despite the order in MA No.1198/2020 dated 31.07.2020 observing that no further extension will be granted to make the payment, seeks once again further time to make the payment. The only difference is that earlier, out of a sum of Rs.1 crore 40 lakhs, only Rs.20 lakhs had been paid but now Rs.1 crore has been paid but still there is an outstanding of Rs.40 lakhs plus overdue interest. Learned counsel submits that time may be granted up to end of February, 2021.

Learned counsel for the appellant, after some arguments does not oppose this request but seeks enhancement

of interest payable which was stipulated as 6 per cent in the order dated 31.07.2020.

We grant time to the respondent/applicant to make payment before the end of February, 2021 but interest rate applicable now for the defaulted amount in the defaulted period would be 8 per cent per annum simple interest instead of 6 per cent per annum.

The Miscellaneous application is disposed of.

CONMT.PET.(C) No.640/2020 in C.A. No.6655/2010

In view of the order passed in MA Diary No.21359/2020, the Contempt Petition is disposed of with liberty to revive the same in case the amount is not paid henceforth.
