UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

By the impugned judgment, the High Court has dismissed the writ petition filed by the petitioner which was filed

seeking payment of the amount due to the petitioner for having carried out a certain civil work.

Today, when the matter came up, it is common case that the amount payable to the petitioner under the bill submitted has been paid to the petitioner on the basis of the orders passed by this Court.

Today, however, Ms. Uttara Babbar, learned counsel for the petitioner, would place even another point which goes to right of the petitioner to get interest on the principal amount. In regard to the same, the petitioner drew our attention to the letter dated 20.01.2018.

We would think as regards the interest, if advised, it is for the petitioner to work out its remedies open in law. Without prejudice to the same, the special leave petition is disposed of.

It is certainly open to the respondent to take all objections available in law in the event of the petitioner lodging proceedings ventilating the petitioner's grievance in regard to payment of interest.
