This special leave petition has been filed against the order dated 03.09.2019 passed by the High Court on the application filed by the private respondent under Section 482 of Cr.P.C.

A perusal of the order indicates that no relief has been granted to the writ petitioner except that in paragraph 3 it has been observed that liberty was reserved to the petitioner

(applicant) to substantiate the allegations before the Trial Court.

We do not find this to be a fit case to be entertained under Article 136 of the Constitution of India. The special leave petition is dismissed.

However, it shall be open for the petitioner to appear before the Trial Court and take all his pleas.
