The petitioner-wife has filed the petition under Section 25 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 before this Court seeking transfer of Matrimonial Suit RCS HM-274 of 2019 titled "Aarti Sharma Vs. Saurabh Saraswat" pending before the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Bhopal to the Family Court of competent jurisdiction at Mathura, Uttar Pradesh.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and taking into consideration the grounds taken in the transfer petition, we direct the transfer of Matrimonial Suit RCS HM-274 of 2019 titled "Aarti Sharma Vs.
