O R D E R

1. The respondent-contemnor no.2 has filed an affidavit dated 29.6.2017, on his behalf and also on behalf of respondent-contemnor no.1, accepting the charge of having published an advertisement in the Business Line newspaper dated 19.03.2012. He has also stated, that he regrets the issuance of the publication and apologises for the same. The apology tendered by the respondent-contemnor is unqualified.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents-contemnors nos. 1 and 2, as a matter of respect to this Court states, that the respondents will make a voluntary contribution of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees one lakh only) to the Supreme Court Bar Association, so as to be used by the Supreme Court Bar Association for upgrading its library. He also states, that the aforesaid deposit shall be made within one week from today, and proof of the same shall be furnished to the Registry of this Court, within a further period of one week.

3. In view of the apology tendered by the respondents-contemnors, as also, the voluntary contribution made by them, we are satisfied, that the rule issued to the respondents deserves to be discharged. The same is accordingly discharged.

4. Disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
