**UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R**

- 1) After hearing learned counsel appearing on behalf of the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case which relates to a scam in the University, reporting the alleged financial defraud by all the petitioners. It is also a fact that the special leave petitions preferred by Mr. Jitendra Kumar (SLP (Crl.) No.7000/2025 @ D.No.22186/2025), Mr. Manoj Gupta(SLP (Crl.) No. 7168/2025 @ D.No. 24324/2025), Dr. Ashok Kumar (SLP (Crl.) No.8245/2025 @ D.No.27267/2025) and Mr. Sunil Agarwal(SLP (Crl.) No.8215/2025 @ D.No.27269 of 2025) asking pre-arrest bail have been rejected by this Court.
- 2) Considering all these aspects, we are not inclined to grant anticipatory bail as prayed for. Accordingly, the special leave petitions stand rejected. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
- 3) However, the officers are at liberty to take recourse as permissible.
