1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner-wife seeking transfer of O.P. No.01 of 2018 titled "Bommisetti Vishwanath v. B.R. Nalini" pending before the Court of Principal Senior Civil Judge, Madanapalle, Andhra Pradesh, to the Court of the Principal Family Judge at Bangalore (Karnataka).

2. Despite service of notice, the respondent-husband has not chosen to appear and oppose this petition. In the light of above, we have heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioner-wife and perused the averments made in the instant petition.

3. In the facts and circumstances of the case, the transfer petition is allowed and case bearing O.P. No.01/2018 titled "Bommisetti Vishwanath v. B.R. Nalini" pending before

the Court of Principal Senior Civil Judge, Madanapalle, Andhra Pradesh, shall stand transferred to the Court of the Principal Family Judge at Bangalore (Karnataka) for hearing and disposal in accordance with law. 4. On receipt of the case records, the transferee Court is directed to make all endeavour for amicable settlement, failing which for early decision in the case without unnecessary adjournments.
