O R D E R

Heard Mr. Amit Kumar, learned counsel for the
petitioners, Mr.Ajit Kumar Sinha, learned senior counsel

for the Union of India and Mr. Vikas Singh, learned senior counsel for the Medical Council of India.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties, we are of the considered opinion that the Medical Council of India shall conduct fresh inspection within the time schedule for the the academic year 2018-2019 and if any deficiencies are found the same shall be intimated to the petitioner who shall also be afforded the opportunity to remove the same as per regulations. After the deficiencies are removed the letter of permission would be granted by the competent authority. Before any final decision is taken the Central Government shall consider the Oversight Committee that has been constituted as per the Constitution Bench decision in W.P.(C) No.408 of 2017 titled as "Amma Chandravati Educational and Charitable Trust & Ors. vs. Union of India & Anr." rendered on 18th July, 2017.

Needless to say the Medical Council of India shall do the needful in a time bound manner so that the petitioner-institution does not feel aggrieved that his case is not considered for the academic year 2018-2019.

With the aforesaid observations, the writ petitions stand disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.
