UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. The parties are personally present in the Court today.
2. The petitioner - wife is far more willing to go back to her matrimonial home and discharge all her matrimonial obligations. The parties have a son who is 2 ½ years of age and has also come today along with his maternal-grandmother.
3. The respondent - husband has few issues, however, all such issues can always be resolved by talking and by trying to bury all differences.
4. We request the parties to continue talking with each other. The endeavour should be to save the marriage in the interest of their minor son. Son should be the only consideration for the parties to reconcile.

We are sure that with the passage of time, everything will be fine and the parties will start residing together as one happy family.
7. Post these matters after four weeks.
8. On the next date of hearing, the parties shall once again personally remain present before us.
