The writ petition is filed under Article 32 of the Constitution of India by the wife of the 1st respondent seeking transfer of the petition for dissolution of marriage filed by the 1st respondent in the Court in Maharashtra. The petitioner is residing along with her daughter in Jammu.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties, we are of the view that the petition must, in the interest of justice, be allowed. Accordingly, the writ petition is allowed. Towards this end, the Registry will send copy of this order to the Principal District Judge at Jammu, who will make it over to the competent court.
