In terms of order dated 11.12.2020, the matter was referred to Ms. Laila Ollapally, learned advocate/mediator at Bangalore.

With the persuasive abilities of the learned mediator and the efforts of Ms. Aruna Gupta and Mr. Nitin Singh, learned advocates for the parties, the parties have settled the matter and the Settlement Agreement dated 22.03.2021 has been placed on record.

The parties are represented by Ms. Meenakshi Arora and Mr. Jitendra M. Sharma, learned Senior Advocates. Both have conveyed that the parties would abide by the terms of Settlement Agreement. Their statement is taken on record. The Settlement Agreement dated 22.03.2021 shall form part of the record of this Court.

In terms of the Settlement Agreement dated 22.03.2021, the cases mentioned in Paragraph 2 of said Agreement stand transferred to this Court and stand disposed of.

The other terms of the Settlement Agreement which are to be obeyed, shall be strictly complied with by the parties.

One of the terms contemplates that the money lying with Mr. Anil Verma, Advocate, resident of Agra, shall be paid to Dr. Anurag Tondon on the day, the Court accepts the joint prayer of the parties. It is ordered accordingly.

Since we have accepted the joint prayer of the parties, Mr. Anil Verma shall hand-over the amount to Dr. Anurag Tondon.

The matter thus stands disposed of in terms of the Settlement Memo dated 22.03.2021.

In the end, we must record our sincere appreciation for the efforts put in by the learned mediator and Ms. Aruna Gupta and Mr. Nitin Singh, learned advocates for the parties. It is only because of their efforts that the acrimonious proceedings between the parties could get settled.

This contempt petition is thus disposed of.
